

Amendments to the By-Laws of St George Sikousis Syllagos:

For Vacancies on the Board of Directors due to resignation:

Article 31 – Resignation Upon receipt of a director's written resignation, the board will acknowledge and announce the resignation at its next regularly scheduled meeting. The resignation will be effective immediately unless otherwise stated. If a future date is stated, the resignation may be withdrawn any time prior to the effective date. Board members who have resigned may not vote on the selection of their replacement. If the resignation is from the position on the executive committee the director will continue serving out their term as a regular board member.

Article 32 - In case of a board vacancy, the remaining board members will fill such vacancy by appointment from among the full paid members list. If the resignation is from the Executive board, then the board will request nominations for the resigned position from amongst the board members. If more than one person expresses an interest then a private ballot vote will be held at the next scheduled board meeting to select the Officer who will then fulfill the unexpired term of the resigned Officer.

To provide for staggering board memberships allowing for continuity:

Article 33 – Current Board Members have been elected to a 2 Year Term. Effective with the election of 2019, 6 of the 10 Current Board of Directors will vacate their seats and open them for election. Those members are invited to run for their seat again at this time. The 6 spots will be for a 2 year term (2019-2021). This will allow for staggered board memberships that will ensure institutional knowledge stays on the board.
